

H&S Meeting - 11/04/20

Updates from Dr. Civian:

1. Rectory renovations - 3 million dollar project, not funded by tuition
2. COVID-19 - all communication will always come from Dr. Civian directly. She has applied for a MEMA grant to continue weekly testing. The teachers are tested on a weekly basis.
3. Ventilation: the classrooms are provided with HEPA clean air machines, covers double the size of room. There is constant wiping down and cleaning of school surfaces as well as the bathrooms, hallways etc. PPE items provided by the city.
4. School yard vandalism - please call the police if you notice anything please. Also email Dr. Civian. Do not get involved.
5. Donations - the school could use some lysol, baby wipes, paper towels, disinfectant spray etc.
ok to have supplies delivered to the school.
6. Before/After School Programs- before school is currently the easiest. It is currently covered by teachers.
After school is being phased, worried about introducing new people/ staff to school even though regular covid tests are required. Hoping to start after thanksgiving. Still trying to figure out how to manage cohorts.
7. The teachers are encouraged to communicate constantly during these difficult times (in a formal or informal way). We want to make sure their needs are met and they feel comfortable coming into school every day.

H&S Goals and Objective for 2020/2021 School year

1. Fundraise \$40,000 (approximately \$18,000 will come from H&S dues). So far, 30% of parents have paid, which is about \$7K. If you are able to contribute more, please do.

There will be no class baskets this year. Considering a neighborhood or spring basket.

The dues will cover holiday and year end bonuses which our teachers appreciate.

Last year the teachers received \$500 and Aides \$250. We'd like to continue showing appreciation to our teachers. We are open to suggestions on how to achieve so. There is a breakfast planned for 11/05. Maybe this is something that can be done for them on a monthly basis. Donations accepted, COVID approved
I (individual packaging etc.)

We'd also like to continue with the tuition raffle - five \$1000 scholarships.

The teachers have some needs which we are encouraging a teachers wish list to be created.

An example of such need is a pottery kiln for art class.

Most recent school purchases have been: umbrellas for the school yard, gardening boxes and basketball hoops.
