COVID-19:

- **Pool Testing:**
 - Program will continue until the end of February.
 - 172 students have been tested with all NEGATIVE results.
 - If your child has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 3+months, please ensure Dr. Civian is aware so they are not included in the testing, as this may skew results.
 - If you would like your child to participate, please email Dr. Civian and Nurse Jaime for the consent form.
- **BinaxNOW:** On-site testing for SBCA staff with results ready in 15 min.
- **Reminders:**
 - If you or a family member in your household has been exposed to COVID-19, please keep all child(ren) out of school and notify Dr. Civian and Nurse Jaime ASAP.
 - **Due to HIPAA, no personal information about a child/staff member will be released. Please do your part and do not spread rumors.** As a reminder, federal law prohibits the school from sharing any personal information about COVID-19 cases. Please do not email them requesting information that they are unable to provide. SBCA is a wonderful community and we ask that you support any impacted families in a positive way.
 - As a reminder it takes everyone working together and doing their part in a positive manner to keep our school open and running smoothly.

Staff Holiday Gift: Gifts were paid the week of December 14th and all staff received between \$300-\$500. The total cost was \$23,885. Dr. Civian received a gift on behalf of the families as well.
